Equipping Us to Be Missionary Disciples

This Sunday, December 15 to Tuesday, December 17, Fr. Francis Ching will deliver a parish mission at our church on the fundamental virtues necessary for growing missionary disciples. These talks are well timed, as they will equip us for our *Alpha as Culture* season. While this is Fr. Francis' third visit to our parish, many still don't know him well. So, here is a brief biography on Fr. Francis:

Fr. Francis Ming Chung Ching was born in Hong Kong in 1972 into a Catholic family. His family immigrated to Toronto in 1986. During his undergraduate studies in Waterloo, he experienced a personal conversion to Jesus and became very active in his faith through involvement with the Waterloo Chinese Catholic Community and an annual young adult retreat called Eastern Canada Chinese Catholic Living Camp (ECCCLC). Shortly after, people began to notice in him a possible vocation to the priesthood and encouraged him to pursue it. A confirming sign came in 1997 at World Youth Day in Paris, France and he decided to begin seminary preparation in 1998.

Joining the Companions of the Cross

Fr. Francis made a couple of visits and was genuinely inspired by the brotherhood and the worship of the Companions at St. Mary's. But initially he did not intend to join them. He felt that the Lord wanted him to minister to the Chinese communities of Toronto. Fr. Francis began Philosophy studies and explored both the semi-monastic and the diocesan lifestyles. However, Fr. Francis was not satisfied, so he re-read the book "*We are Called the Companions* of the Cross," obtained from a previous visit with Fr. Bob Bedard, CC. It was in reading this book that he realized that the Lord was calling him to join the Companions: Everything in the book was exactly what the Lord had been placing on his heart over the years. Fr. Francis joined the community in 1999, and was ordained in 2005.

Fr. Francis was born with glaucoma and is diagnosed as legally blind. His eye condition severely worsened four years into his first assignment at St. Timothy Parish in Toronto due to complications. His condition stabilized after two surgeries and but he lost the ability to read.

Current Ministry

Since July, 2015, Fr. Francis has been doing full-time evangelization work. Half his time is dedicated to helping provide formation and training for the *Fountain of Love and Life*, a Chinese media evangelization charitable organization that produces weekly TV and radio programs, and online web content. With the rest of his time, he gives retreats, parish missions, and workshops wherever he's called to serve. He is also the spiritual director for the Eastern Canada Chinese Catholic Living Camp.
